### **Q&A with Tyisha Spiller**

## Assistant Community Manager for Freedom West Homes

### How long have you been working at Freedom West Homes?

I've been working here since November 2024.

### Where are you from?

### What experience do you bring to Freedom West Homes?

I have been working in property management for four years now. Three of those years I worked for a non-profit organization focused on supportive housing for individuals who were previously homeless or transitioning from a shelter to permanent housing. I also worked for another non-profit organization, which primarily focuses on low-income housing. My workplace was a Rental Assistance Demonstration (RAD) building, where I worked very closely with San Francisco Housing Authority.
