Other vendors will be present to share information on healthy living practices.

Last year, Corbin said about 150 people stopped by to enjoy the Family Day activities, including Supervisor Dean Preston, whose district includes Freedom West. Corbin is expecting even more people this year, and she's hoping that Supervisor Preston will make another appearance, although she is still confirming with his office.

Ericka Scott, another organizer for Family Day, said this year's event will also focus on the history of Freedom West, as exhibited through images. Residents are being encouraged to bring photographs of Freedom West over the years to represent the changing times of the site but also to reinforce the family presence that has always been the foundation of the community.

"We want people to be able to talk about our history here," said Scott, who added

that the residents can provide these images before the event to the Freedom West Alumni Association. "And the best way to show that history is through these photographs that can span generations. Many times, these pictures can tell a story better than words can."
